

The Big Idea Bash 2 Speed Pitching Q&A

What is the Big Idea Bash and why should I attend?

The Big Idea Bash is an annual event that connects entrepreneurs with the organizations that support them. This year, The Big Idea Bash 2 has added a new program that provides entrepreneurs the opportunity to pitch their idea to a VC and get feedback.

How does the speed pitching work?

Selected companies will have 5 minutes to pitch their idea directly to a VC and receive 5 minutes of feedback.

How will the companies be selected?

All interested companies will register on site at the Big Idea Bash 2 between 5 pm and 6 pm. By registering, the company will be entered into the drawing for a 10-minute time slot. All selected companies will be announced and placed on a list between 6:15 pm and 6:30 pm. Speed pitching will begin at 6:30 and last one hour.

How should I prepare to pitch and what can I bring?

The Oregon Entrepreneurs Network has developed an excellent preparation document that is available on the OIF Website. If you want to bring a demo, it must be loaded onto your laptop – we cannot guarantee the availability of wireless Internet access.

What if I am not selected?

All of the participating VCs will be available for networking after the speed pitching session.
